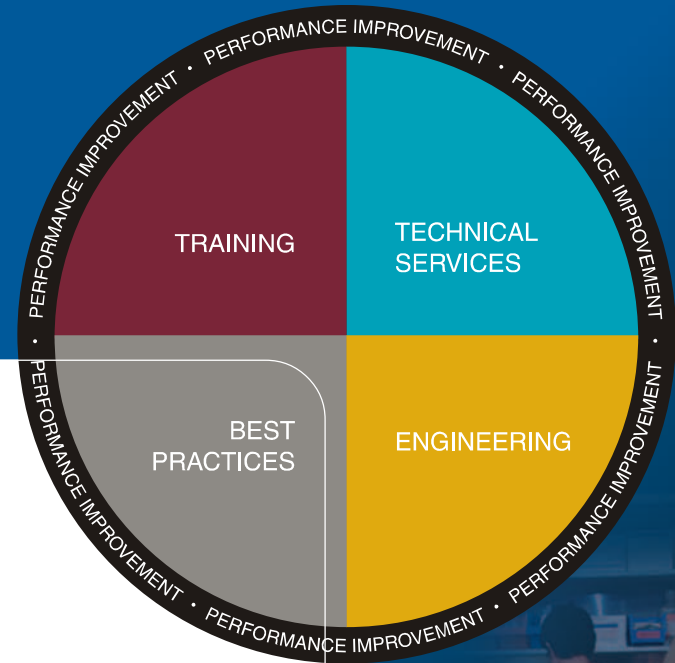

Project Experience

WMD AND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

Department of Homeland Security, Office for Domestic Preparedness Equipment Grant Program (5 years)

- Implemented a nationwide training program on radiological, biological and chemical detection equipment
- Operate the Domestic Preparedness Equipment Technical Assistance Program (DPETAP)
- Provide WMD equipment, PPE and mass decontamination training and technical support to Emergency Responders nationwide
- As of 7/03, provided training to 116 jurisdictions, encompassing over 1,360 courses and a student throughput of over 23,750 first responders, including 3,800 Tabletop/Practical Exercise participants

American Red Cross, Clara Barton Center (CBC) for Domestic Preparedness™ (2 years)

- Operate this national Training Center for Red Cross personnel
- Develop and present courses on WMD response
- Trained more than 700 Red Cross leadership personnel

U.S. Army Chemical Agent Stockpile Program Support

- Since 1989, support emergency preparedness programs at chemical agent destruction facilities located nationwide
- Planned, conducted and evaluated Emergency Response Drills and Exercises at Chemical Agent Disposal Sites
- Since 1989, conducted more than 5,900 courses and trained more than 35,200 students while operating the Army's Chemical Demilitarization Training Facility (CDTF), the central training facility supporting the entire chemical agent disposal program
- Maintained more than 70 courses related to chemical agent disposal and emergency response

U.S. Army Chemical Agent Stockpile Program Support (continued)

- Trained over 2,400 personnel on chemical agent detection, personal protection, and decontamination
- Provided training to laboratory personnel for over 10 years on the detection and monitoring of chemical warfare agents

EPA Region III, Counter-Terrorism & Emergency Preparedness Program (5 years)

- Conduct Outreach Programs to State Emergency Response Commissions, LEPCs and Emergency Responders
- Presented counter-terrorism training programs and tabletop exercises for hospital staff, regulatory personnel, emergency managers, Federal On-Scene Coordinators, and emergency responders

City of New Orleans Response and Recovery Operations

- ROC Staff Support : GP is providing the deputy for each of city's Incident Command System (ICS) Leads: Incident Commander, Logistics, Operations, Finance, and Planning. In the Plans branch, we are providing Documentation Unit, Situation Unit, Resource Unit and Information Unit staff. In addition, GP is providing deputies for some of the Command Staff positions: Public Information Deputy and Safety. GP also provides staffing support to each of the operational "pods" on the ROC floor: Public Safety, Human Services, Transportation, Public Works, Commerce, Housing and Mass Care and Debris Management.
- PA Reimbursement: GP is providing a staff of 4 to assist the city in developing Project Worksheets, gather or locate supporting documentation, and assist in data collection and entry into RAMSAFE software.
- The 311 Call Center is the city's official information line. GP provides a staff of 5 people to man call positions in the 311 Center.

HAZMAT Training

- Conducted training courses since 1989 for government and private sector clients to satisfy 29 CFR 1910.120
- Courses include: First Responder Awareness Level, First Responder Operations Level, HAZMAT Technician, HAZMAT Specialist, and On-Scene Incident Commander

BIOTERRORISM AND HOSPITAL PREPAREDNESS

Statewide Hospital Bioterrorism (BT) Preparedness

- Conducted statewide BT Preparedness Assessments for TX, CA, TN and PA to identify key preparedness needs of hospitals and clinics
- Assessed preparedness status of over 900 hospitals and 150 clinics. Results were used by States to prioritize future actions and expenditures
- Developed Regional Plans for BT Response
- Designed and conducted Regional Exercises to test BT Response Plans

Hospital WMD Incident Readiness Support

- Developed/reviewed WMD specific plans, procedures, and policies for a major New York hospital
- Identified specialized equipment and supplies needed for hospital operational continuity as a result of a terrorist incident involving WMD
- Provided WMD awareness (four hours) level training for entire hospital staff and operations (16 hours) level (hands-on) training for hospital emergency responders
- Developed and conducted hospital drills/exercises to evaluate implementation of WMD incident procedures
- Conducted Infectious Disease Outbreak Exercises for the County Department of Health

Hospital Emergency Management Plan Upgrade

- Developed an All-hazard Emergency Management Plan for a nationally recognized Hospital Center
- Developed a customized Hospital Incident Command System (ICS)

Hospital Incident Command System Training

- Conducted several Hospital Emergency Incident Command System (HEICS) training course for Louisiana Dept. of Health

Anthrax Decontamination Support

- Provided Anthrax decontamination support to Federal agencies and facilities in the Washington, DC area
- Supported preparation of a Decontamination Plan and Waste Management Plan for the anthrax decontamination of a major office building
- Managed the decontamination of anthrax contaminated mailrooms in another facility and provided consulting support for anthrax response to a Federal agency
